The Proceedings will be published in the journal *Radiocarbon* (<u>radiocarbon.org</u>). As with all papers in *Radiocarbon*, the Proceedings will be peer-reviewed. The published papers will also appear online via *Radiocarbon*'s Cambridge Core site (<u>cambridge.org/RDC</u>).

Authors will submit their papers via *Radiocarbon*'s online manuscript management site, https://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/rdc. The Author's submission page features a pull-down list of article types. To ensure proper issue assignment, please scroll down and select Type "Conference Paper" and the special issue from the pull-down menu is "2021 RIE III Conference" for this Proceedings issue. Important

Proceedings articles up to 8 printed pages long will be published free of charge to participants, but due to the high number of submissions expected, *length restrictions will apply* to all submissions.

Please limit your manuscript to 4500 words and 4 figures, which calculates to roughly 8 printed pages. To avoid excess pages, authors of longer papers are encouraged to submit some tables, figures, and/or data as free online supplemental material.
